Thank you for your flexibility and support! The students have continued to learn despite our challenging times and we look forward to seeing them even more during the fourth quarter!



Health Protocols

WAVE will continue to follow our protocols established in our Reopening Guide.

Gentle reminders:

- Screen students for COVID symptoms each day, self-report if you are sick, and keep students at home if any symptoms are present.
- Inform the instructors if the student has a chronic condition, such as allergies or asthma that would account for certain symptoms.
- WAVE students using transportation provided by LHUSD, must follow the processes and procedures established by LHUSD.
- Staff members will visually check each student for symptoms as the students enter the building.
- Students and staff will wear masks when entering the building and at all times when present on campus.
- Students and staff are expected to wash hands with soap and water as directed and frequently.
- Hand sanitizer will be strategically placed in the building for student and staff use.
- Visitors will continue to be limited.
- Staff and students will continue to implement daily cleaning and disinfecting procedures.

 - You will come to WAVE Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, AND Friday now!
 - All Sophomores are Periods 1 AND 2
 - All Juniors and Seniors are Periods 5 AND 6
- Google classroom will be used in class
 - Your assignments will still be posted here
- Wednesday - WAVE Campus closed - appt only
- The WAVE bus is still available for transport between campus and the high school.
- COVID precautions still in place: masks required, frequent sanitizing, hand washing, barriers, and distanced seating.
